Prof. N. Pradhan, Principal extended heartly welcome to Prof. R.J. Rao, Chairperson and all the members of the Management Committee. He informed the house regarding the detailed procedure of formulating PAC proposals. He intimated about the collection of state needs by state coordinators and confirmation of these needs in the state coordination committee meeting held every year. These needs are translated into programme proposals. These proposals are scrutinized in Pre-IAB meeting and after incorporation all suggestion these proposals are discussed in details in Institute Advisory Body (IAB) meeting. The programme proposals approved in IAB are placed in the Institute Management Committee meeting. The programme proposals passed in this management committee will be placed in the Programme Advisory Committee (PAC) to be held at NCERT (HQ), New Delhi for final approval.

### **Agenda 1.**

The 56<sup>th</sup> meeting of management committee was held on March 5, 2020 under the Chairmanship of Prof. R.J. Rao, the then Vice Chancellor, Barkatullah University, Bhopal. The minutes were confirmed by the house unanimously.

## Agenda 2.

Under this agenda the various activities of the Institute were presented as under:

**2.1. Admission to various courses of the Institution:** No admission test was conducted for admission in any course due to COVID-19 pandemic. Merit wise list of candidates were prepared and the students were called for online verification of the documents. The admission was held in three phases, and all the seats have been filled.

**2.2. Campus placement cell:** More than 60 schools contacted the Institute for placement purpose but due to COVID-19 lockdown during the time, schools could not visit the Institute for conducted of interview for placement.

**2.3. Academic Activities** – Prof. P. Kulshreshtha, Head, DEE, presented the academic activities of the Institute. He informed the house regarding various courses like Two year B.Ed., 2 year M.Ed., 3 Year B.Ed. M.Ed., 4 year B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.A. B.Ed. integrated programme run in the Institute. He informed the house about number of Ph.D. scholars enrolled and, the number of students admitted in various courses (B.Sc. B.Ed., B.A. B.Ed. 2 year B.Ed. and M.Ed. and 3 year B.Ed.-M.Ed. integrated course) for the session 2020-21. Finally, he spelt out the results of University Examinations for the last session. He also mentioned about the admission in to various courses (B.Sc. B.Ed., B.A. B.Ed. 2 year B.Ed. and M.Ed. and 3 year B.Ed.-M.Ed. integrated course) and selection procedure through CEE Entrance Examination.

**2.3. Student Council Activities:** Prof. Chitra Singh, Chief Advisor, Students' Council, informed about the Student Council activities for the year 2020-21. She throw light on the various activities carried out during the session, including commemoration of days of significance, extracurricular (cultural & literary) and sports events/competitions of students. She talked about 11 activities that were conducted as per the instructions received from NCERT (HQ) and MoE. Most of the activities were conducted online following COVID-19 guidelines.

**2.4. Internship in Teaching** – Dr. Sarika C. Saju, Associate Professor, presented the details of Internship programme conducted in this Institute during the current session. She explained comprehensively on almost all aspects of Internship Programme in force for students of all courses being run by the Institute. She told that following COVID-19 regulations, internship committee innovated various activities that can be done as part of internship by the students in their locality. The innovative internship programmes were appreciated by many other Institutions of the Country.

**2.5. Diploma Course in Guidance and Counselling (DCGC)** – Dr. Saurabh Kumar, Assistant Professor, highlighted upon the salient features of the course. Speaking in detail, he informed the house about the duration of the course, its content and the

modes it is conducted through. The programme commences in the month of January and concludes in the month of December. Teachers, specially from the KVS, NVS, Government institutions, were given preference in admission to the course while a few left over seats were offered to private candidates as well. All the 50 seats were filled for the year 2020-21.

**2.6. Library:** Dr. P.K. Tripathy, Deputy Librarian of the Institute submitted the report of Institute Library development during the year 2020-21. Due to COVID – 19 pandemic the Institute Library (Learning Resource Center) was physically shut down from March to December 2020 for students but they were allowed for on-line access to the contents stored in its **e-Library** from their homes. Despite pandemic, the Institute library has taken up some initiatives in the year 2020 to enhance the services for its users and development of its infrastructure.

**2.7. NCC:** Prof. Rashmi Singhai, NCC Officer, presented the report of both wings of NCC (boys and girls). She reported enrolment of 107 girls and 53 boys in NCC in the current session. She informed the house about the motivation, encouragement and support being given to every cadet to attend B & C Certificate NCC camps.

**2.8. Staff News** – This part of agenda was presented by Prof. P. Kulshrestha, Head DEE of the Institute. He detailed about the posting, transfer, promotion, retirement and superannuation of staff members.

### **Agenda: 3.**

#### **Programmes conducted for the year 2020-21:**

Prof. Praveen Kulshreshtha, Head DEE presented the facts and figures and the progress of the PAC programmes. He discussed about the PAC programmes that were conducted during the session 2020-21. Out of 60 programs, approved by PAC of NCERT, 47 were completed, 07 could not be initiated, 05 were carried-over and 01 programme was transferred.

### **Agenda: 4.**

#### **4.1. Programmes to be conducted for the session 2021-2022:**

Prof. Praveen Kulshreshtha, Head DEE placed a total of 73 programmes to be conducted for the session 2021-22. But as per the suggestions by Director's nominee, Prof. A.K. Srivastava, and Prof. R.J. Rao, VC, BU, Bhopal, it was decided that only required programmes which would help in implementation of NEP-2020 should be kept during the session keeping the COVID-19 restrictions in view. It was decided that a sub-committee of the management committee will be formed to select the relevant PAC programmes from the given list.

The meeting of the sub-committee of management committee was held on April 21, 2021 through online mode under the chairmanship of Prof. A.K. Srivastava, Dean (Research), NCERT, New Delhi. The other members of the committee were Prof. Bipin Bihari Beohar, Prof. Vrashabh Prasad Jain and Prof. B. Ramesh Babu. Prof. N. Pradhan, Principal was the member Convener of the committee. The sub-committee, after careful analysis, recommended 32 programmes for the session 2021-22.
