ch table. Data presented in the tables need to be understandable by readers and explainable to the queries of readers as far as possible. <u>Authors need to use research language (easy language, no high sounding words) in the description/analysis.</u>

Major Findings

Findings should contain pin-pointed descriptions (point wise) derived from the Result section with referral of statistical data. It should be a brief summary of results/discussion. Readers can be able to understand; relate the findings to the result/discussion section. Corroboration of findings with studies reviewed earlier needs to be done.

Educational Implications

As it is a journal of education, it is the objective to generate educational ideas and implications among the academia.
