NCERT: THE PREMIER BODY IN SCHOOL EDUCATION: The National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) develops the curriculum, textbooks and instructional materials and trains the key functionaries and conducts research in various dimensions of school education. The NCERT functions through its eight constituent units, viz. National Institute of Education (NIE), (b) Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET) - both located at New Delhi, (c) Pandit Sunderlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE), Bhopal and five Regional Institutes of Education (RIEs) at Ajmer, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Mysuru and Shillong. The certificate, diploma and advanced diploma programmes in the teaching of English are currently being offered by RIE, Bhopal.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES: To train in-service teachers, teacher educators, school administrators and untrained English teachers in English language learning, skills, pedagogy and classroom management are the objectives of the programme.

RELEVANCE OF THE PROGRAMMES: English is one of the most important languages to be learnt and taught at school level. It is observed that the teachers of English in rural and semi urban areas do not have adequate fluency and appropriate pedagogy in the language. The "Certificate and Diploma Programmes in Teaching of English" (CDPTE) aim at providing them an opportunity to develop good fluency and skill in English and make them use better pedagogy for English teaching. The Programmes are based on the recommendations of NEP 2020 and have many courses that promote the policy recommendations like Multilingual Classroom, Learning Outcomes, Inclusive Language Learning, Experiential Learning, Project and Task-based Learning, Constructivist Approach, Teachers' Autonomy, Gamification of Language Learning, Research and Publication, etc. to name a few. The course content is prepared in consonance with the National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCF-SE), 2023 to empower the teachers to develop required competencies in the learners. The Programmes also promote the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations including inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all (G4) and productive employment and decent work for all (G8). These SDG reiterate the objectives of NCERT in promoting societal values to develop good citizens. They will also equip the teachers with the skills of 21st century like critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication that are essential for modern students to succeed in school and the workplace.

PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS: The Programmes consist of components in English language learning and teaching it as a second language in the multilingual contexts. They not only include the basic language skills like listening, speaking, reading and writing but also the advanced language skills like communication

skills, pronunciation, note-making, academic writing etc. The content of the courses also include innovative and emerging pedagogy of English language teaching like art-integrated, experiential, constructive and gamified learning for an enjoyable English language learning experience. The new pedagogy of task, project, and competency-based language learning is also included in the course content. They stress on the alternative participatory approaches like teaching language through literature and language across the curriculum. The programmes are created to train the teachers to create and use not only physical learning teaching materials like chalk/ink boards, realia, toys, working models, etc. but also the digital learning materials, e-resources, e-content, multimedia etc. The courses will also empower the teachers to use multiple modes of learning like flipped classroom, online classes, MOOCs, MOODLE, etc. that has become a new-normal in teaching during the post Covid-19 era. They will motivate the teachers to innovate and research in English classrooms and present and publish research papers and finally, the courses will help the teachers to reach beyond the classroom and associate and collaborate with other teachers, institutions, organisations for continuing professional development.

COURSE CONTENT: The course content has been developed by National ELT experts including faculty and teachers from EFL-University, IITs, NITs, RIEs, KVS, and other reputed institutions. The course content includes the following materials:

- 1. 03-12 Course Books including 50 modules for self and guided learning for 3-12 months.
- 2. 20-80 Video (e-content) prepared by experts and faculty of NCERT.
- 3. 15-50 Infographic videos for revision of the lessons.

Self-learning material in modular form is the mainstay of this course. The material covers the topics and provides a foundation for acquiring knowledge, attitudes and skills in the teaching of English. One module consists of 15 hours of self-study in about 5000-8000 words. There are 12-13 modules for the certificate programmes, 25 modules for the diploma programmes and 50 modules for the advanced diploma programmes.

PROGRAMME TRANSACTION: The Programmes are offered by Regional Institute of Education, Bhopal. They are self-financing programmes that will run annually in blended mode. The learners will do self-learning using text and video materials during the weekdays. The faculty expert will engage weekly online classes to discuss important topics during the weekends.

PROGRAMMES: There are four certificate programmes spread over two academic years. The duration of the certificate programmes is six months each. Every certificate programme will have three courses to study in the blended mode. Each programme is of 20 credits.

1. CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE EDUCATION (CELE): July – December 2024: This programme is designed to orient teachers about the broader issues in English Language Teaching in India.

MULTIPLE ENTRY AND EXIT: The candidates will have option to take multiple entry into the certificate and diploma programmes and exit with a relevant degree i.e. in 6 months they will earn a certificate, in 1 year they will earn a diploma, and in 2 years they will earn the advanced diploma. The Institute will provide multiple entry through certificate and diploma programmes to earn the advanced diploma at the maximum flexible time of 5 years through this scheme.

DURATION AND PHASING: The Programmes are for a period of one year, spread over three phases as given below:

*Guided Self-Learning: During the distance learning phase, every week the learners will study one self-learning material (modules), watch one or two videos, attend online class by experts and complete tasks related to the module. All the four components will be assessed.

@ Intensive Practicum: Contact programme consists of intensive practical training and supervised field experience in schools. Duration of the contact programme is 7 for days for the Certificate Programmes, 15 days for the Diploma Programmes, and 01 months for the Advanced Diploma Programmes. It will be followed by a period of 3-10 month of internship in actual job setting, i.e. schools, guidance agencies etc. In-service candidates must ensure that they will have to attend the contact programme in the face-to-face mode with due permission from their employers before they take admission. Selected candidates will not be allowed to pursue any other Programme from any University/Institution, if they join the contact programme.

#Internship: Candidates will be required to undertake an internship in a school, agency or any other educational institution for the specified period under the supervision of an assigned expert and submit their reports/records at the end of the internship.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION: Preference in admission will be given in the following way:

- 1. In-service English teachers with teaching degrees.
- 2. Graduates who are currently not working as an English teacher but have a teaching degree and at least two years of teaching experience.
- 3. Postgraduates in English/ELT/Linguistics/Education. Preference will be given to those with at least one year of teaching or related experience.

PROGRAMME FEE AND OTHER EXPENSES: Course fee to be paid by different categories of candidates before commencement of the Programme is:

ASSESSMENT METHOD: Appearance in all the examination/assessment type is compulsory. Grades will be calculated over total marks secured by a candidate irrespective of the scores of individual papers.

CERTIFICATION: Certificate, Diploma or Advanced Diploma will be awarded by NCERT on fulfilling requirements for successful completion of each phase and attaining a certain level of proficiency in each aspect of the programme.

ADMISSION PROCESS

INTAKE: The total number of seats is maximum 50 for the Certificate programmes 25 for the diploma programmes and 25 for the advanced diploma programme.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Candidates willing to apply for the programme should deposit the required entrance fee (Rs.100) in the following ways:
 - a. UPI transfer to SBI A/C 10026515348; Fill this format Fee Receipt Format https://shorturl.at/aXjQK).
 - b. SBI Collect>Education Institutions (Short by State)>RIE Bhopal Principal>Other Payment (take screenshot of the fee paid on SBI Collect).
- 2. After the fee deposit, they should fill the Registration Form using the Google form link https://shorturl.at/gX7YB and upload required documents including the scan/screenshot of fee payment.
- 3. Merely filling the form does not make the candidate eligible for admission. Only shortlisted candidates based on the eligibility and other criteria will take an online selection test which includes MCQs and interview. The weightage of entrance test and interview is 70 and 30 marks respectively.
- **4.** The admission in each course (certificate, diploma and advanced diploma) will be given to the suitable candidates on the basis of their performance as per NCERT norms.
- **5.** The selected candidates will pay the required course fee to join the course.
