B.Ed.

Candidates with at least 50% marks in Bachelor Degree and /or in the Master Degree in Sciences/Bachelor in Engineering or Technology with specialisation in Science or Mathematics or in Bachelor Degree and /or in the Master Degree in Social Sciences/Humanities are eligible for admission to the programme (relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwD candidates).

Reservation of Seats
